WHAT IS A SCHOLARSHIP FUND?

A Scholarship Fund gives the donor(s) an opportunity to help local students achieve their educational goals. The Community Foundation will work with the donor to create guidelines for their scholarship and will administer the application and award process. Donors can determine selection criteria and serve on the recipient recommendation committee. A gift of at least \$20,000 is required to open an endowed scholarship fund; \$1,100 is required for a non-endowed fund.

Scholarship Funds can be named in recognition of the donor(s), a family member, friend or organization. Or select a name that will ensure your anonymity.
